
Sensory Guide







General Considerations

- Duration: 2 hours 15 minutes
 - Allegro Brillante 16 minutes
 - Pause 5 minutes
 - Wartime Elegy 19 minutes
 - Intermission 25 minutes

- Note that decibel levels recorded for this guide include times of applause and sound levels will vary depending on the specific audience
- Durations for each scene are approximations and may vary


