BALLET SUN VALLEY ANNOUNCES REPERTOIRE HIGHLIGHTS AND TICKETS ON SALE FOR 2026 SUMMER FESTIVAL WITH WORLD-REOWNED PACIFIC NORTHWEST BALLET

Pacific Northwest Ballet set to deliver two unforgettable performances in the Sun Valley Pavilion June 27 and 28 – including a co-commissioned World Premiere from Choreographer, Jessica Lang.

SUN VALLEY, IDAHO, January 28, 2026 – Ballet Sun Valley (BSV) announced today that **tickets for the 2026 Summer Festival will go on sale on February 4** and unveiled repertoire highlights for the in-person debut of Pacific Northwest Ballet (PNB), led by Artistic Director Peter Boal. Across two nights, June 27 and 28, PNB will perform **two entirely different programs**.

A highlight of this year's Festival is a **new co-commissioned work** from PNB Resident Choreographer **Jessica Lang**, which will receive its **world premiere** on the Sun Valley Pavilion stage.

Other notable repertoire highlights include **Rubies** from George Balanchine's legendary **Jewels**; Twyla Tharp's beloved **Nine Sinatra Songs**; **The Window** by Dani Rowe; **Red Angels** by Ulysses Dove; with other works to be announced.

Tickets for the 2026 Summer Festival go on sale **February 4, 2026**. Prices begin at **\$35** and can be purchased online at **balletsunvalley.org** or through the **Sun Valley Resort Recreation Office** at **208.622.2135**.
